Biblical Response to Unjust Suffering

The Value of Work:

Shown by Examples...

- God, Genesis 1...esp. v. 31.
- Jesus, John 5:17; Hebrews 1:3.
- Apostle Paul, Acts 20:32-35; II Thess. 3:6-9

The Value of Work:

Shown by Instructions...

- God to Adam, Genesis 1:28; 2:7-8, 15-16.
- Paul to the Ephesians, Colossians, and Thessalonians.

The Value of Work:

Shown by Predictions...

Believers in the New Jerusalem, Revelation 22:3-5.

The Value of Work:
Shown by Its Benefits...

Work is not the result of the Fall!

Work is a divinely designed way of manifesting the image of God and fulfilling the will of God!

As such, work done in a noble way <u>is noble</u>, as an expression of God's will for the individual!

The Instruction to be in Submission, 18.

The Attitude of Submission: "with all respect," 18.

The Extent of Submission, 18.

- Not only to those who are good!
- Not only to those who are gentle!
- But also to those who are unreasonable!

The Specific Example of Submission—Suffering unjustly, 19-20.

- Unreasonable!
- Unjust!
- Harsh!

The Reasons For Submission, 19-21

- Favor (Grace!) with God, 19-20
- Conscience toward God, 19.
- Live a "credit-worthy" life!, 20.
- Fulfill your calling, 21.
- Follow your Example, 21ff.

## CONCLUDING THOUGHTS CONCERNING SUBMISSION:

- 1. God will reward our faithful suffering! James 1:12; Rev. 2:10
- 2. God is able to deliver us, when and if He chooses! Remember Acts 12!
- 3. God will avenge our ill-treatment! Romans 12:19.
