# **IPETER:** HOLY AND HOPE-FILLED LIVING IN A HOSTILE WORLD

## I PETER 5:1-5

We need to live HOLY AND HOPE-FILLED LIVES, In effective churches with Godly elders

- Who is speaking? Peter!
  - Fellow-Elder!
  - Witness of the sufferings of Christ!
  - Partaker of the glory that is to be revealed!

To Whom is he speaking? "The Elders Among you!"

- Elder is from "presbuteros"!
- Those who Shepherd the flock
- "Those exercising oversight" (Overseeing) from "episkopeō"

"Elders," "Overseers" ("bishops," in KJV) and "Pastors" ("shepherds") all refer to the same men, but emphasize different aspects of their roles!

#### **TWO BIBLICAL OFFICES...**

- 1. "Elder" / "Overseer" / "Pastor"
- 2. "Deacon" (meaning "servant")

Deacons...

- ✓ Acts 6:1-3. "Deacon," "Deac," "Deaconing"
- ✓ Philippians 1:1
- ✓ I Timothy 3:1-7 (elders), 8-13, Deacons!

### IDEALLY, **A CHURCH SHOULD HAVE A PLURALITY OF BOTH ELDERS** AND DEACONS

**INTRODUCTION TO ELDERS, I PETER 5:1-5** The Command to the Elders: "Shepherd the flock of God among you." "Shepherd" is a command! It is the flock "of God!" It is the flock "Among you"!

#### From Acts 20:28-35, "Shepherding" Involves...

- Teaching..."Feeding" the flock
- "Watching over" the flock
- Protecting the flock
- Being on the alert (for himself AND the flock!)
- Admonishing each one.
- Recognizing your accountability to God!
- Being a man of "the Word of His grace"!
- Helping the weak...willing to give.
- Working hard!

- The Instructions To The Elders: "Taking oversight"
- "Not under compulsion"
- "Willingly"
- "According To The Will of God"
- "Not for sordid gain"
- "with eagerness"

The Instructions To The Elders: "Taking oversight"

- "Not 'lording it over' those allotted to your charge"
- "Becoming an example to the flock."

In order to live HOLY AND HOPE-FILLED LIVES, in the midst of a hostile culture, we need to be actively involved in our local church, which needs to be led by humble and godly leaders.
