II Corinthians 5:20

AMBASSADOR:

a diplomatic agent (often of the highest rank) assigned to a foreign government as the resident representative of his or her own government.

AMBASSADOR:

- Our citizenship is in heaven,
 Philippians 3:20.
- We are heaven's and Christ's chosen and assigned representatives, to earth and mankind!

- Seek to please God, 5:9.
- Know that they are accountable to God, 5:10.
- Seek to please both God and men, 5:11-13.
- Are motivated by the Love of Christ, 5:14.
- Are living for God, not for themselves, 5:15.
- Have, themselves, become new creatures in Christ, 5:17.

- Have been given the ministry of reconciliation,
 5:18.
- Have been committed the word of reconciliation, 5:19.

THE GOSPEL:

- 1. Christ died for our sins!
- 2. Christ rose again the 3rd day!

- BEG, on behalf of Christ: "Be reconciled to God," 5:20.
- Understand the incredible price of our salvation,
 5:21.
- Are careful not to cause offense in anything, and discredit our ministry, 6:1-4.

Keep on "keeping on," in the power of God (6:7)
as ambassadors of Christ, 6:4-10

Your Commission:

You are an ambassador of Christ!

Your Mission: The Ministry of reconciliation, proclaiming the word of reconciliation, begging on behalf of Christ, "Be reconciled to God."
