DO WE REALIZE HOW HIGH A STANDARD "WORTHY OF THE LORD" REALLY IS???


COLOSSIANS 1:15-19

- His Person, 15.
 - ✓ He is the image of the invisible God

 "Image" ←> "eikōn" ≈ "icon"

- His Person, 15.
 - ✓ He is the image of the invisible God
 - ✓ He is the firstborn of all creation "Firstborn" is a title of position or "rank." IT does not require a "birth."

- His Work, 16.
 - ✓ He is the creator of all things!
 - → In the heavens and on the earth
 - → Visible and invisible




"Chiastic" Structure

- His Work, 16.
 - ✓ He is the creator of all things!
 - → In the heavens and on the earth
 - → Visible and invisible
 - → Whether thrones or dominions
 - → Or rulers or authorities.

ALL THINGS have been created through Him!

- His Work, 16.
 - ✓ He is the creator of all things!
 - ✓ He is the purpose of all things!



JESUS IS THE CREATOR!!!

"Prepositional Creation"

- He is the Personal Cause: "All things were created BY (¿v) Him!"
- He is the Intermediate Agent: "All things have been created THROUGH ($\delta\iota\dot{\alpha}$) Him.
- He is the Ultimate Purpose: "(all things were created) FOR (εἰς) Him!"

- His Rank, 17-18.
 - ✓ He is "before" (πρό) all things
 - "Before" in time.
 - "Before," as in, "in front of."
 - "In Him, all things hold together"

- His Rank, 17-18.
 - ✓ He is "before" all things "In Him, all things hold together"
 - ✓ He is the head of the Body ← The Church
 - ✓ He is The Beginning
 - ✓ He is the firstborn from the dead.

His Rank, 17-18.

SO THAT He Himself will come to have first place IN EVERYTHING!!!

5 times in vv. 16-18, "all" or "every"

"Walking Worthy Of The Lord" Is the highest standard we can imagine!!! AND WE ARE CALLED TO DO IT!!!
