THE TARGET FOR A CHRIST-WORTHY WALK: **CHRIST!**, (Colossians 1:15-19)

- His Person, 15.
 - ✓ He is the image of the invisible God
“Image” ↔ “eikōn” ≈ “icon”

THE TARGET FOR A CHRIST-WORTHY WALK: **CHRIST!**, (Colossians 1:15-19)

- His Person, 15.
 - ✓ He is the image of the invisible God
 - ✓ He is the firstborn of all creation
 - “**Firstborn**” is a title of position or “rank.”
 - IT does not require a “birth.”

“Chiastic” Structure

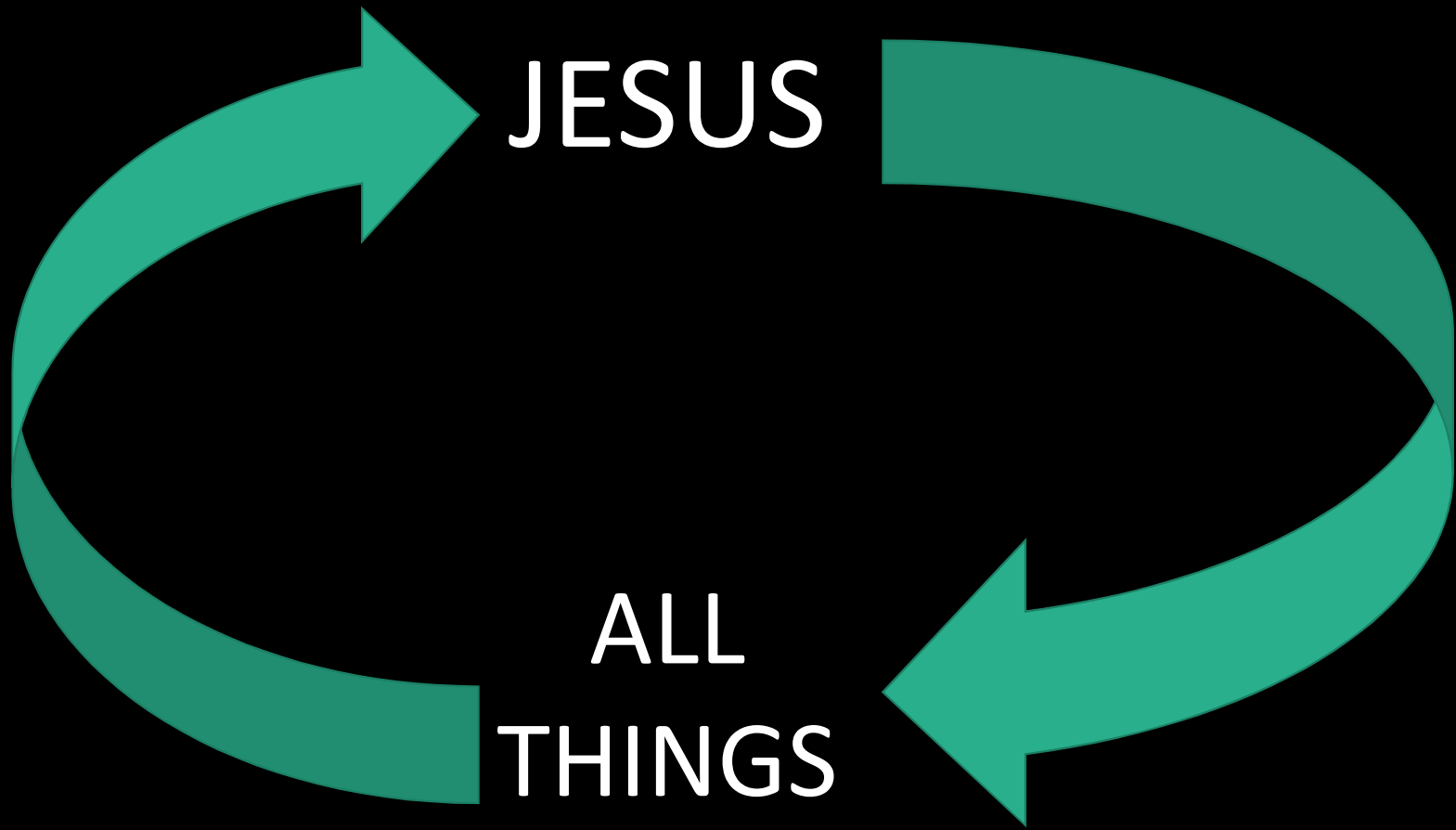
THE TARGET FOR A CHRIST-WORTHY WALK: **CHRIST!**, (Colossians 1:15-19)

- His Work, 16.
 - ✓ He is the creator of all things!
 - In the heavens and on the earth
 - Visible and invisible
 - Whether thrones or dominions
 - Or rulers or authorities.

ALL THINGS have been created through Him!

THE TARGET FOR A CHRIST-WORTHY WALK: **CHRIST!**, (Colossians 1:15-19)

- His Work, 16.
 - ✓ He is the creator of all things!
 - ✓ He is the purpose of all things!



JESUS IS THE CREATOR!!!

“Prepositional Creation”

- He is the Personal Cause:
“All things were created **BY** (ἐν) Him!”
- He is the Intermediate Agent:
“All things have been created **THROUGH** (διὰ) Him.
- He is the Ultimate Purpose: “(all things were created) **FOR** (εἰς) Him!”

THE TARGET FOR A CHRIST-WORTHY WALK: **CHRIST!**, (Colossians 1:15-19)

- His Rank, 17-18.
 - ✓ He is “before” (**πρό**) all things
 - “Before” in time.
 - “Before,” as in, “in front of.”
- “In Him, all things hold together”

THE TARGET FOR A CHRIST-WORTHY WALK: **CHRIST!**, (Colossians 1:15-19)

- His Rank, 17-18.
 - ✓ He is “before” all things
 - “In Him, all things hold together”
 - ✓ He is the head of the Body ↔ The Church
 - ✓ He is The Beginning
 - ✓ He is the firstborn from the dead.

THE TARGET FOR A CHRIST-WORTHY WALK:
CHRIST!, (Colossians 1:15-19)

- His Rank, 17-18.

SO THAT He Himself
will come to have first place
IN EVERYTHING!!!

5 times in vv. 16-18, “**all**” or “**every**”

- ✓ The Application of His Reconciliation, 21-23.

The Accomplishment of His Reconciliation

- The Agent of His Reconciliation: “through Him”
- The Extent of His Reconciliation: “All things”
- The “Target” of His Reconciliation: “To Himself”

II Cor. 5:20: “Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ,
as though God were making an appeal through us:
we beg on behalf of Christ,
‘Be reconciled to God.’”

The Accomplishment of His Reconciliation

- The Agent of His Reconciliation: “through Him”
- The Extent of His Reconciliation: “All things”
- The “Target” of His Reconciliation: “To Himself”
- The Result of His Reconciliation: “Peace”
- The Means of His Reconciliation: “through the blood of His cross”

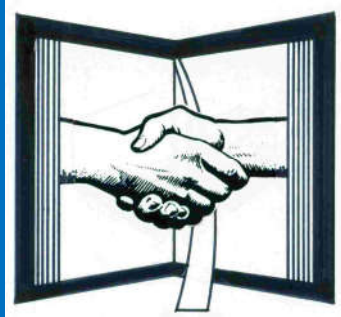
