COLOSSIANS 1:1-5

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ who are at Colossae: Grace to you and peace from God our Father.

We give thanks to God,
the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
praying always for you,
since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus
and the love which you have
for all the saints;

because of the hope laid up for you in heaven, of which you previously heard in the word of truth, the gospel

THE AUTHORITY FOR A WORTHY WALK

 $ἀπόστολος <math>\longleftrightarrow$ "apostolos"

TRANSLATED = TRANSLITERATED = "MESSENGER" "APOSTLE"

"Saints"
