Growing in Christ: The Power...

- "Latreia Living"
 → "Worship-Service" Lifestyle
- Have Meaningful Encounters with One Another: Body-Life, Community; Serving and Being Served!
- "Mind-Control"
- Facing Temptations
- Enduring Trials and Suffering!

Basic Considerations:

- Unbelievers will worship just about anything...EXCEPT GOD, Romans 1:21-25.
- God is seeking people to worship Him, in spirit and in truth, John 4:19-24

Basic Considerations:

 Worshiping God is a distinguishing characteristic of true believers, Philippians 3:3

Basic Considerations:

 The early Church met on the first day of the week for corporate worship, I Cor. 16:1-2; Acts 20:16, 6-7

Basic Considerations:

 Believers are admonished NOT to forsake the assembling of ourselves together! Hebrews 10:24-25

Benefits of Corporate Worship:

- 1. Stimulate one another to love.
- 2. Stimulate one another to good deeds.
- 3. Encourage one another!

We both DO these and RECEIVE these!!!
