- Money as eternally worthless, 19-31

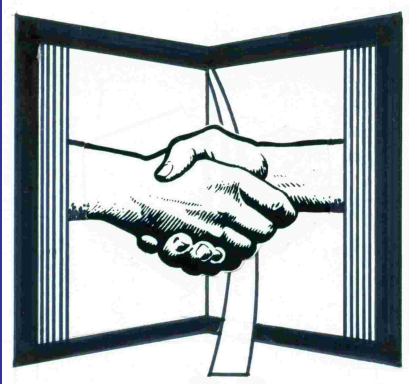
Luke 15-16:
