- It is a New Covenant kind of ministry, 3:6.

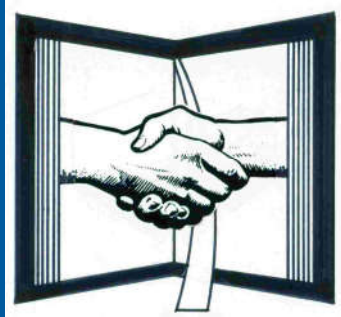
AMBASSADORS' MINISTRY FOR CHRIST (II Corinthians):
