Qualifications Of Forgiveness...

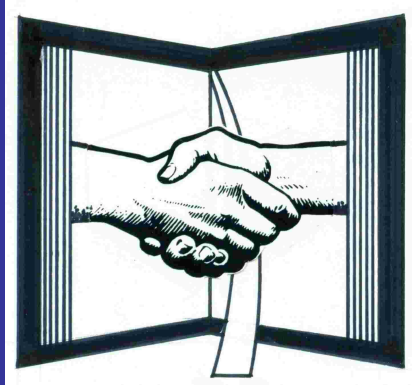
- Does not necessarily restore trust!
