We should live...

- ✓ Negatively: “Deny ungodliness and worldly desires”
- ✓ Positively: “Live sensibly, righteously, godly....”
- ✓ Expectantly...Watchfully: “Looking for the Blessed Hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Christ Jesus”

The Blessed Hope

The Appearing of the Glory
of our Great God and Savior,
Christ Jesus

⇔ The “Rapture”
of the Church

The Rapture of the Church
is that future event
when Jesus will return to the “air,”
and “catch up” His Church,
both raising those who have died,
and translating those who are still alive,
to take them to heaven
to be with Him forever.”

DIFFICULTIES IN STUDYING THE RAPTURE:

1. The word, “rapture,” does not appear in the Bible.
2. There is no single passage that clearly teaches about it.
3. Some passages that sound like they are describing the rapture are not.

DIFFICULTIES IN STUDYING THE RAPTURE:

4. The doctrine of the rapture requires a **BROAD UNDERSTANDING** of prophetic and eschatological Bible passages. The Rapture “fits” within a “framework” of eschatology.

THE DESCRIPTIONS OF THE RAPTURE:

- Titus 2:13
- 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
- 1 Corinthians 15:50-58

The proper understanding of the rapture and prophecy should produce...

1. An understanding of what is going on and what is coming.
