⇔ The "Rapture" of the Church

The Rapture of the Church is that future event when Jesus will return to the "air," and "catch up" His Church, both raising those who have died, and translating those who are still alive, to take them to heaven to be with Him forever."

DIFFICULTIES IN STUDYING THE RAPTURE:


- 1. The word, "rapture," does not appear in the Bible.
- 2. There is no single passage that clearly teaches about it.
- 3. Some passages that sound like they are describing the rapture are not.

DIFFICULTIES IN STUDYING THE RAPTURE:

4. The doctrine of the rapture requires a BROAD UNDERSTANDING of prophetic and eschatological Bible passages. The Rapture "fits" within a "framework" of eschatology.

The Rapture will only involve The Church!

- POST-TRIBULATION RAPTURE
- MID-TRIBULATION/PRE-WRATH RAPTURE
- PARTIAL RAPTURE

HAVE THE CHURCH...OR PART OF IT...
GOING THROUGH PART OR ALL
OF THE TRIBULATION

Therefore, if we can demonstrate that no part of the Church goes through any part of the Tribulation, we will have demonstrated the validity of the Pre-Tribulation Rapture view.

- The Tribulation is the 70th of the 70 "7"s of Daniel 9 and they are all for Israel.
- The Church is not mentioned in Revelation 4-19, which covers the Tribulation.
- In Revelation 7, there is a distinction between Jews and Gentiles, which does not exist in the Church.

- In Matthew 24:15-21, during the Tribulation, they will be observing the Sabbath, which was exclusively for Israel, not the Church.
- Christians are delivered from "the wrath to come," Matthew 3:7; 1 Thess. 1:10.

- In 1 Thess. 5, the Day of the Lord is coming like a thief in the night!
 - ✓ But we are sons of light and are not in the darkness, vv. 4-5.
 - ✓ God has destined us for "salvation," not wrath, 9.
