


MOAB

"Now it came about in the days when the judges were judging...."


Two Important things about when the judges were judging...



CHAOS IN JUDGES...

In those days there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes. Judges 17:6;21:25

- The Famine and the Flight, 1-2.
 - ✓ Elimelech ⇔ "My God is King"
 - ✓ Naomi ⇔ "fair," "pleasant," "lovely"
 - ✓ Mahlon \Leftrightarrow "sickness," or "disease"
 - \checkmark Chilion \Leftrightarrow "destruction," or "pining"



- The Losses and the Grief, 3-5.
 - ✓ Elimelech dies!
 - ✓ Both boys marry Moabite women.
 - ✓ Both sons die!

- The Return To Bethlehem, 6-22.
 - \checkmark The decision to return, 6-9.
 - \checkmark The discussion about the return, 10-13.
 - ✓ The decision NOT to return (Orpah), 14.
 - ✓ The determination TO return (Ruth), 15-18.
 - \checkmark The disruption at the return, 19.

- The Return To Bethlehem, 6-22.
 - ✓ The disappointment, at the return, 20-21.
 ✓ The details of the return, 22.

- Like Job, Job 1:20-22.
