   Having nothing bad to say about us, 8!
- We will adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in every respect, 10!

- ✓ Positively: "Live sensibly, righteously, godly...."

- ✓ Zealously: "Zealous for good deeds"

  God's Grace Teaches Us To Live...
- ✓ <u>Negatively:</u> "Deny ungodliness and worldly desires"
- ✓ Positively: "Live sensibly, righteously, godly...."
- ✓ Expectantly...Watchfully: "Looking for the Blessed Hope..."
- ✓ Zealously: "Zealous for good deeds"

## BIBLICAL INSTRUCTION, Titus 2:15 Responsibilities of the Hearer:

- Recognize the authority of these instructions!
- Do not disregard them!!!

## BIBLICAL INSTRUCTION, Titus 2:15-3:1 Responsibilities of the Teacher:

- "Speak" "With All
- "Exhort"
- "Reprove" Authority!!
- "Let no one disregard you"
- "Remind them...."

#### PRACTICAL GODLY LIVING Titus 3:1-11.

- Regarding Authority, 3:1
- ✓ Be subject to rulers!
- ✓ (Be subject to) authorities!
- ✓ Be obedient!
- ✓ Be ready for every good deed!

#### WHAT DOES THIS LOOK LIKE?

#### **SUBMISSION TO RULERS: Romans 13:1-7**

- ✓ It is NECESSARY to be in submission, 1, 5.
- ✓ Obedience...not resistance...to the authorities God has established, Rom. 13:1-2
- ✓ Rulers are "ministers" of God, 4, 6.
- ✓ Submission, for fear and for conscience' sake, Rom. 13:4-5

#### SUBMISSION TO RULERS: Romans 13:1-7

✓ Render taxes and customs and fear and honor to those to whom it is due, 7.

#### SUBMISSION TO RULERS: 1 Peter 2:11-12, 13-17

- ✓ It is part of our "good deeds" before unbelievers, 11-12.
- ✓ Submission to rulers and authorities is <u>God's</u> will for believers, 13-<u>15</u>.
- ✓ Honor all people, love the brotherhood, fear God, honor the king, 17.
  - Cf. Acts 23:3-5...Paul apologizes!

#### **SUBMISSION TO RULERS: Daniel 1**

- ✓ If a conflict arises between men's and God's instructions, try to propose an acceptable alternative, 1:8-16.
- ✓ Be willing to suffer the consequences of disobeying man's law, 1:13...also Dan. 6.

#### SUBMISSION TO RULERS: Acts 4-5

✓ When man's law is contrary to Scripture, and uncompromisable, then "we must obey God, rather than men," 4:19-20 5:29-32.
