- We will adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in every respect, 10!

- "Setting Straight"...Our Personal Lives
 God's Grace Teaches Us To Live...
- ✓ Negatively: "Deny ungodliness and worldly desires"
- ✓ Positively: "Live sensibly, righteously, godly...."
- ✓ Expectantly...Watchfully: "Looking for the Blessed Hope..."
- ✓ Zealously: "Zealous for good deeds"

- Responsibility needs to be earned and deserved before bestowed.
- There are no "nobodies" to God!

FINAL COMMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS, 3:12-14 Paul's Provision:

Diligently send Zenas the lawyer and Apollos forth, so that nothing is lacking for them.

MISSION SUPPORT??

ASIDE: THE IMPORTANCE OF MISSIONARY SUPPORT, 3 JOHN 5-8

- It is an act of faithfulness, 5
- It includes whatever you do for them!
- It is to be done for the brethren, even if they are strangers
- It is a demonstration of love, 6
- It brings positive testimony to the church

ASIDE: THE IMPORTANCE OF MISSIONARY SUPPORT, 3 JOHN 5-8

- You are doing well.
- You should send them in a manner worthy of the Lord.
- They are going out for the sake of The Name,
 7
- They are accepting nothing from the Gentiles (unsaved)

ASIDE: THE IMPORTANCE OF MISSIONARY SUPPORT, 3 JOHN 5-8

- We OUGHT to support such men, 8.
- We become fellow-workers with the truth!

SOME PROBLEMS WITH MISSIONARY SUPPORT:

- Some missionaries may take 3-5, or more years to raise support!
- Support may be "spread out," making "furlough" exhausting.
- Mission board "fees" increase the amount of support that must be raised.
- Missionary is "subject" to changes in supporting churches or individuals.

AN ALTERNATIVE TO MISSIONARY SUPPORT... "Tent-Making" Missionaries, Acts 18:1-4 Some Advantages...

- May get to the "field" much more quickly!
- May be able to get into countries that "missionaries" can't!
- Not subject to "loss of support" according to church changes back home.

AN ALTERNATIVE TO MISSIONARY SUPPORT... Tent-Making Missionaries, Acts 18:1-4 Some Advantages...

- May have more natural "contacts."
- May not seem so..."American"!
- May be better able to relate to the "normal" lifestyle of the nationals.

AN ALTERNATIVE TO MISSIONARY SUPPORT... Tent-Making Missionaries, Acts 18:1-4 Some DIS-Advantages...

- Need to have a "marketable skill" that is needed in the "target" country!
- May need a separate college degree BESIDES Bible/theological training.
- May not "recruit" an "army" of pray-ers to pray for them.

AN ALTERNATIVE TO MISSIONARY SUPPORT... Tent-Making Missionaries, Acts 18:1-4 Some DIS-Advantages...

 Having to work a full-time job may limit the amount of time the missionary can devote to evangelism and discipleship.

Hidden benefit: More "national" involvement from the very beginning!

"Retiree" Missionaries

Some Advantages...

- Retirement income ⇔ no support raising!
- May be able to get into countries that "missionaries" can't!
- They have a legitimate sounding reason to BE in the foreign country.

"Retiree" Missionaries

Some Advantages...

 Since they don't have to work, they have more time to evangelize and disciple!

"Retiree" Missionaries

Some DIS-Advantages...

- May not want to leave children, grandchildren, and..."comfort"
- Older age often ⇔ less energy & strength to evangelize & disciple and start a new church.

"Retiree" Missionaries

Some DIS-Advantages...

 May have more difficulty learning language, culture, and customs; and may be less "adaptable."

BOTTOM LINE: MISSIONARY SERVICE...

There are lots of different ways that people can serve as missionaries.

- Raising support
- "Tent-making"
- Retirees

There are advantages and disadvantages to each...but opportunities ABOUND!
