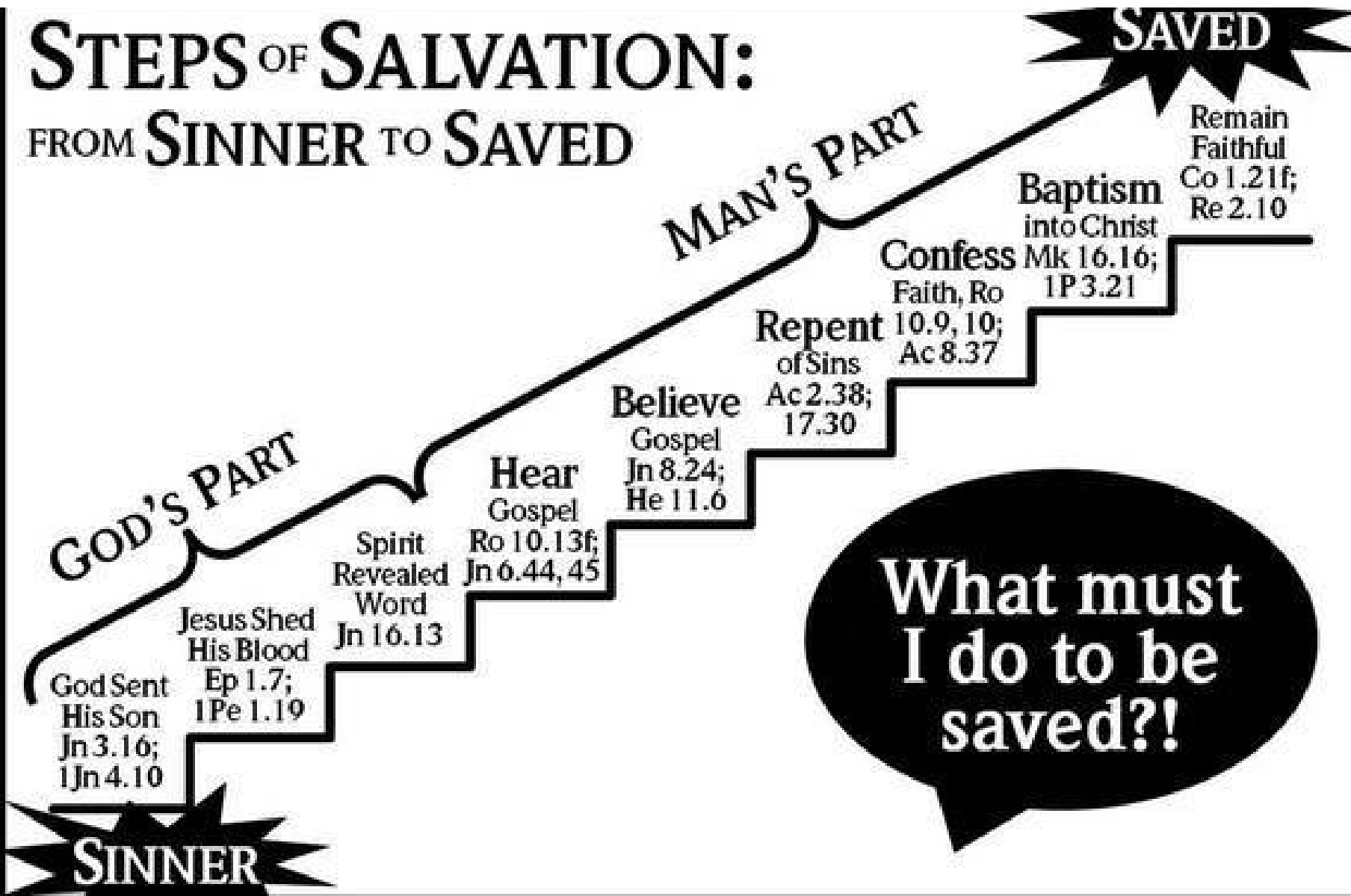

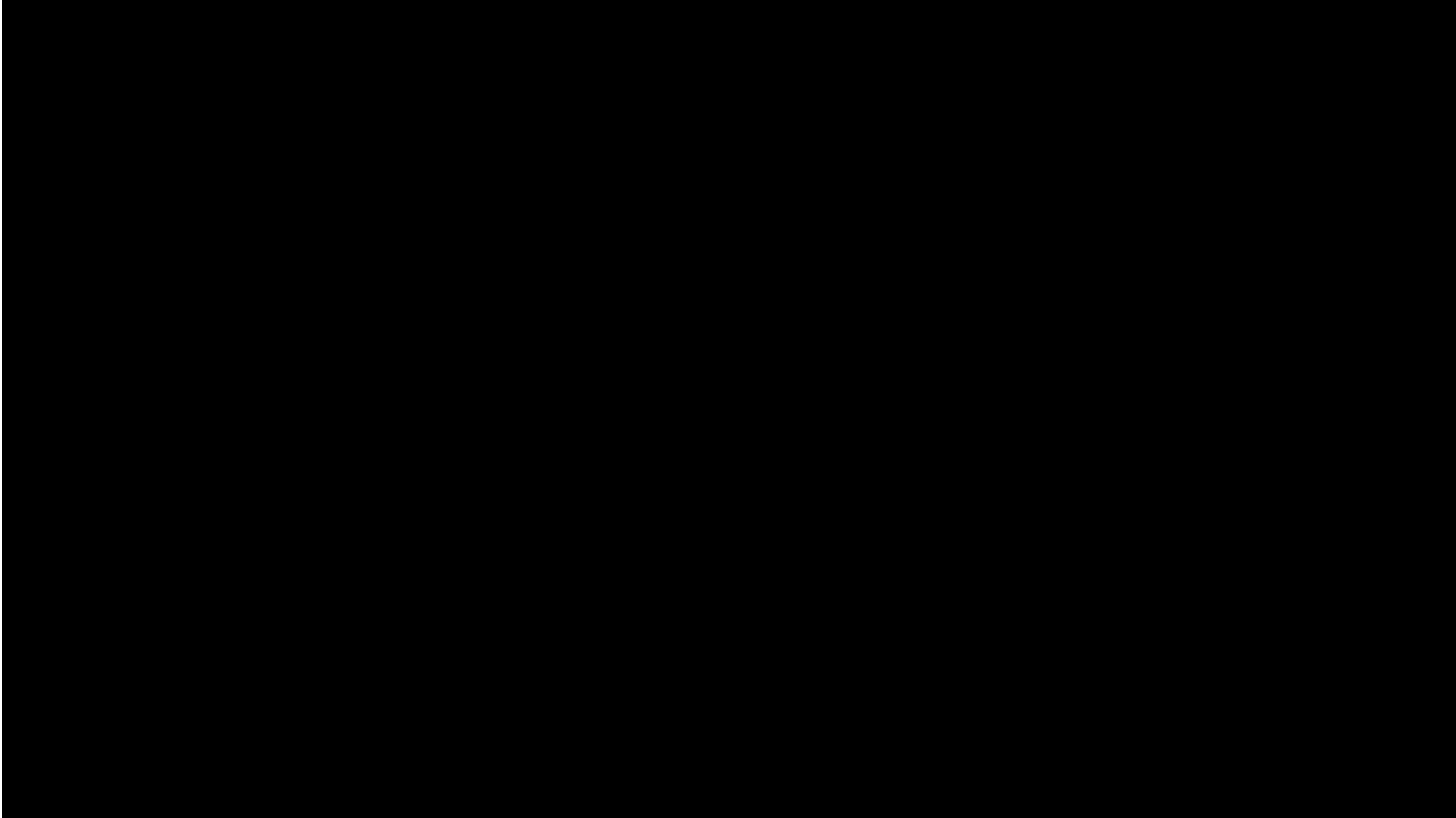
STEPS OF SALVATION: FROM SINNER TO SAVED

FOUR WORDS:

1. God!
2. Mankind
3. Jesus Christ
4. Response

Ephesians 2:8-9

Pastor Dave's Plan:

1. Man's problem: Sin! Romans 3:23.
2. Man's danger: Death! Romans 6:23.
3. God's Offer: Free gift of eternal life.
Romans 6:23.
4. How to receive that gift: by faith (believing).
Ephesians 2:8-9
NOT by any kind of works!

Pastor Dave's Plan:

5. WHAT you have to believe: the gospel! I
Corinthians 15:1-5, esp. 3-5.
 - ✓ Christ Died For Your Sins!
 - ✓ He Rose Again the 3rd Day!

6. Your Response: IF you will believe, you will
have eternal life! John 6:47

The Bad News...

1. We are all sinners. Romans 3:23

ILLUSTRATION: Throwing a rock!

2. The penalty for sin is death. Romans 6:23.

ILLUSTRATION: Wages!

The Good News...

1. Christ died for you! Romans 5:8.

ILLUSTRATION: Cancer.

2. You can be saved through faith in Christ.

Ephesians 2:8-9

ILLUSTRATION: Chair.



“THE ROMANS ROAD”

- All have sinned, Romans 3:23
- The wages of sin is death, Romans 6:23
- God loves you and sent Jesus to die for you, Romans 5:8.
- You must believe in Jesus, and confess with your mouth, Jesus as Lord, Romans 10:9-10.
- You must call on the Name of the Lord to be saved, Romans 10:13.

“THE ROMANS ROAD”

So...WHAT does a person have to do to be saved???

- Believe in Jesus.
- Confess with your mouth, Jesus as Lord.
- Call on the Name of the Lord.

What about the verses...

**over 100 of them...that say you are
saved by FAITH ALONE IN CHRIST ALONE???**

Using Romans 10:9-10 and Romans 10:13
introduces unnecessary confusion
to the plan of salvation,
and adds an element of human works
("confessing Jesus as Lord with your mouth")
to the simple, Biblical truth
that we are saved by faith alone
in Christ alone.

“REPAVING” THE ROMANS ROAD

- All have sinned, Romans 3:23.
- We all deserve eternal death, Romans 6:23.
- God loves us and sent Christ to die for us, Romans 5:8.
- Jesus died and rose again, Romans 4:25.
- Therefore, God offers salvation/eternal life/justification as a free gift, Romans 6:23.

“REPAVING” THE ROMANS ROAD

- We receive that free gift simply by believing in Jesus, Romans 3:26; 4:5.

According to Romans 4:5,
God declares “righteous” the
Ungodly Person
Who does NO WORKS
But who **BELIEVES IN JESUS!**

“But Jesus rose again from the dead, and is alive in heaven, now, and if we simply believe in Him, that He died for our sins, God will forgive us and give us eternal life.”

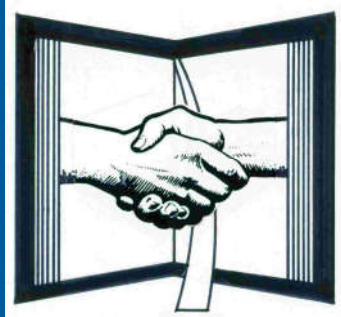
