

- "in the 2nd month" v. 11...the month of Ziv?
- "the 17th day of the month"

- Noah (+1) v. 7
- Noah's wife (+1)
- Sons: Shem, Ham, Japheth (+3)
- Sons' wives. (+3)
- = 8 people (cf. 2 Peter 2:5 "but saved Noah, one of eight people")
- Clean animals v. 8
- Unclean animals v. 8
- Birds v. 8
- Everything that creeps on the earth v. 8
- Male and Female

COMMON CULTURAL TRADITIONS OF A FLOOD (OVER 200 ACCOUNTS!)

- Is there a favored family? 88%
- Were they forewarned? 66%
- Is flood due to wickedness of man? 66%
- Is catastrophe only a flood? 95%
- Was flood global? 95%
- Is survival due to a boat? 70%
- Were animals also saved? 67%

COMMON CULTURAL TRADITIONS OF A FLOOD: (OVER 200 ACCOUNTS!)

- Did animals play any part? 73%
- Did survivors land on a mountain? 57%
- Was the geography local? 82%
- Were birds sent out? 35%
- Was the rainbow mentioned? 7%
- Did survivors offer a sacrifice? 13%
- Were specifically eight persons saved? 9%

"All" or "every" occurs 6 times!

"<u>only</u> Noah was left, together with those that were with him in the ark." THE CONCLUSION OF THE FLOOD, GENESIS 8:1-22

- God "remembers" Noah, 1-5.
- Noah "tests" the waters, 6-12.
- The waters dry up and the earth is dry, 13-19.
- Noah Worships, 20-22.
