




Built together...dwelling of God in the Spirit, 22.

The Allowance For the Setting Aside, Daniel 9:24-27

DANIEL 9:24-27



"Seventy sevens have been decreed for your people [Israel] and your holy city...."

But what about the "GAP"???

The time period of the "Gap" has

NOT necessarily been decreed for Israel.

It ALLOWS for God to work through the Church.

And the fact that God is now working in and through the Church during "the Gap" does not in any way diminish the certainty that He will complete His decreed plan for Israel!

Romans 9:1-3 Paul's Grief Over Israel

- The Sincerity of his Grief, 9:1
 - "Telling the truth in Christ"
 - "Not lying"
 - "My conscience testifies with me in the Holy Spirit"

Romans 9:1-3 Paul's Grief Over Israel The Expression of his Grief, 9:2

- "I have great sorrow..."
- "[I have]...unceasing grief in my heart"

Romans 9:1-3 Paul's Grief Over Israel

- The Extent of his Grief, 9:3
 - "I could wish that I myself were accursed (anathema)..."
 - "...separated from Christ"

Romans 9:1-3 Paul's Grief Over Israel

- The Concern of his Grief, 9:3
 - 2 Descriptions...the 2nd clarifying the 1st.
 - "My brethren..."
 - "My kinsmen according to the flesh"

- The Glory

Romans 9:4-5 God's Blessings on Israel

- The covenants
 - ✓ The Abrahamic Covenant, Genesis 15
 - ✓ The Mosaic Covenant, Exodus 19:3-8
 - ✓ The Palestinian Covenant, or The Land Covenant, Deuteronomy 28-30
 - ✓ The Davidic Covenant, 2 Samuel 7:8-17;
 1 Chronicles 17:7-14
 - ✓ The New Covenant, Jeremiah 31:31-34

- The Temple service
- The promises
- The Fathers
- From whom is the Christ, according to the flesh
