(This Builds on Romans 12:9-21)

- It is commanded, 8.
- It is a “debt,” 8. (Recall v. 7)
- It fulfills the Law, 8.

- IT Does No Wrong to a Neighbor, 10.

- Because **“salvation” is nearer to us than when we believed!,** 11

“Salvation” in Romans

σώζω, σωτηρία

- “Spiritual salvation,” 1:16.
- “Deliverance” from temporal wrath of God, 5:9-10.
- Physical deliverance of the Jewish remnant during the Tribulation, 10:9-10, 13.
- “Ultimate Salvation” ...the glorification of the believer, 13:11. Cf. 8:18-19, 23.

The Importance of Holy Living, Romans 13:11-14.

- Because we know the “season,” 11.
- Because it is already the “hour” for us to be raised out of “sleep,” 11.
- Because “salvation” is nearer to us than when we believed!, 11
- Because the night is almost gone and the day is near, 12.

The Practice of Holy Living, Romans 13:11-14.

Let us...

- Lay aside the deeds of the darkness, 12
- Put on the armor of the light, 12

The Practice of Holy Living, Romans 13:11-14.

Let us...

- Behave properly as in the day, 13

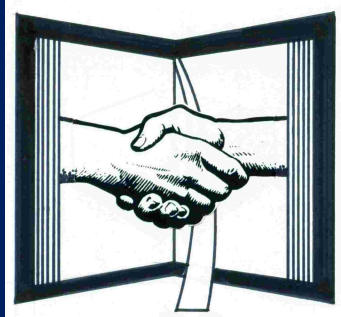
Not in...

- ✓ Carousing and drunkenness!
- ✓ Sexual promiscuity and sensuality
- ✓ Strife and jealousy

BUT...

- Put on the Lord Jesus Christ, 14
- Make no provision for the flesh in regard to its lusts, 14
