Recognize the “distress” that comes from trials.

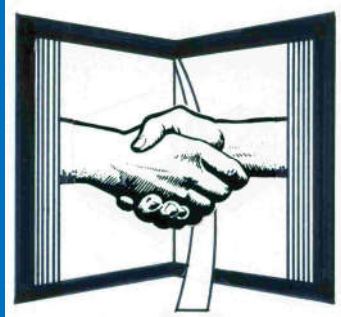
## COPING WITH TRIALS, I PETER 1:6-9
