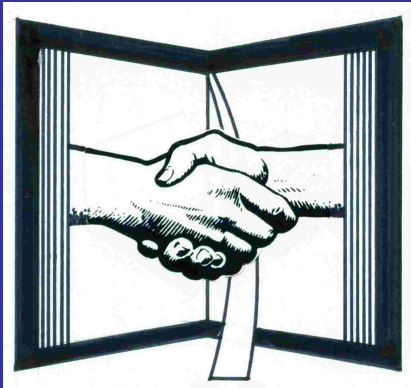
- Summer Fruit, 8:1-14
