We can all “serve”...“deak”

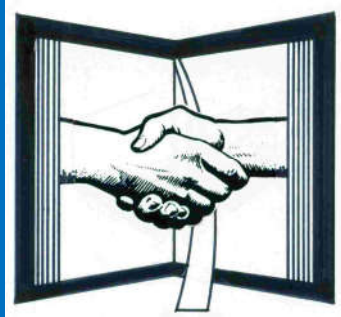
And we are all called to be “servants”

- Ministry-mindset, “I was made a minister,” 25.
- Stewardship from God, “according to the stewardship from God,” 25.
- Grace-Awareness, “bestowed upon me,” 25.
