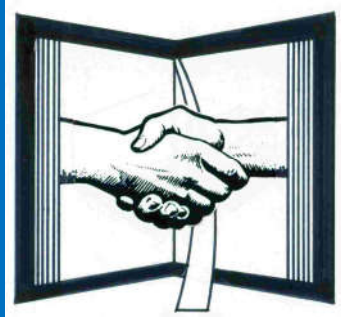
PAUL'S PRAYER FOR THE COLOSSIANS, 1:9-11
