HOW CAN YOU BE ANGRY AND YET NOT SIN?

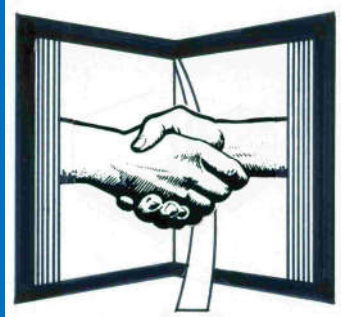
Negatively:
