BOTH ARE IMPORTANT!!!

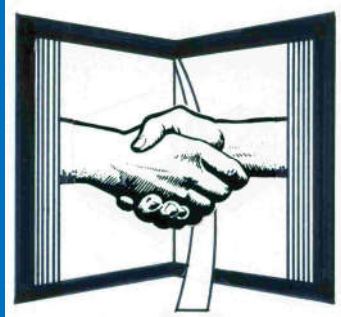
