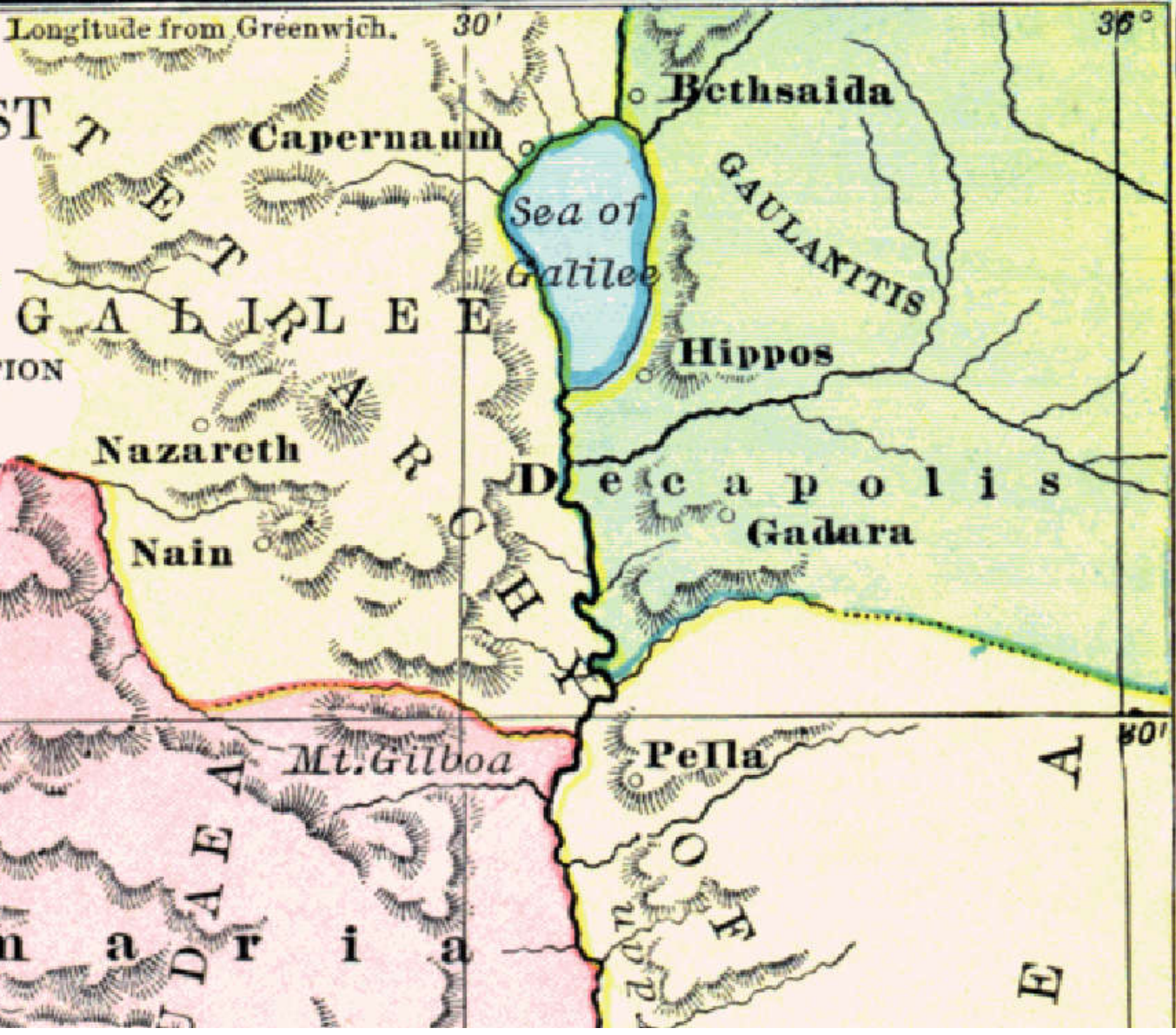

- Leader of the Apostles and believers
- Spokesman for the Apostles to the Crowd at Pentecost
- Leader of the early church.

The Transformation of Peter...Five Factors:

1. The Prayers of Jesus, Luke 22:31-32

✓ Romans 8:33-34; Hebrews 7:25; I John 2:2

2. The Resurrection of Jesus!

3. The Coming of The Holy Spirit!

John 14:16-17; Acts 1:4-5, 8; 2:1ff

✓ Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 12:13; II

Corinthians 1:21-22; Ephesians 1:13-14; 4:30.

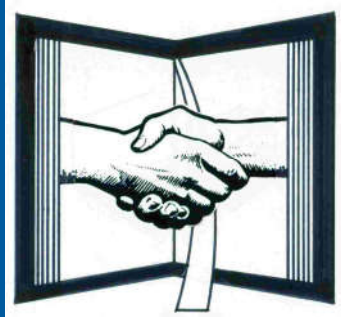
The Transformation of Peter...Five Factors:

4. He Spent Time With Jesus, Mark 3:13-14;
Acts 4:8-13.
5. Jesus' Charge to him, John 21:15-17.
 - ✓ Matthew 28:18-20
 - ✓ II Corinthians 5:20!

WE...

- ✓ Have Jesus praying for us!
- ✓ Have the resurrected Jesus!
- ✓ Have the indwelling Holy Spirit!
- ✓ Can spend time with Jesus in the Word!
- ✓ Have a “charge” from Jesus!
