Love is patient,  
love is kind *and* is not jealous;  
love does not brag  
*and* is not arrogant,  
does not act unbecomingly;  
it does not seek its own,  
is not provoked,  
does not take into account  
a wrong *suffered,*

does not rejoice in unrighteousness,  
but rejoices with the truth;  
bears all things,  
believes all things,  
hopes all things,  
endures all things.  
Love never fails;

*Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor  
what is evil;  
cling to what is good.*

*Be devoted to one another  
in brotherly love;  
give preference to one another  
in honor;  
not lagging behind in diligence,  
fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;*

rejoicing in hope,  
persevering in tribulation,  
devoted to prayer,  
contributing to the needs

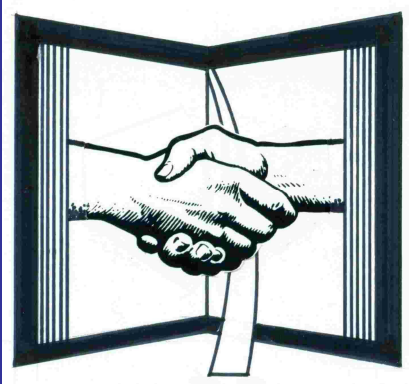
