## Why Study Titus???

- It is God-Breathed Scripture, 2 Timothy 3:16-17.
- Titus was serving in a sinful, hostile culture.
- Titus had been disciplined by the Apostle Paul!

- Saved on the Road to Damascus, Acts 9:1-18.
- Ministry in Damascus, Acts 9:19-25
- Visit to Jerusalem, Acts 9:26-29.
- Paul's "silent ministry" in Tarsus, Acts 9:30-11:25.
- Barnabas brought Saul to Antioch, Acts 11:25





## HIGHLIGHTS OF PAUL'S LIFE

- Famine visit to Jerusalem, Acts 11:27-30; 12:25.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Missionary Journey, Acts 13:1-14:28.



## HIGHLIGHTS OF PAUL'S LIFE

- Famine visit to Jerusalem, Acts 11:27-30; 12:25.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Missionary Journey, Acts 13:1-14:28.
- Jerusalem Council, Acts 15:1-35
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Missionary Journey, Acts 15:40-18:22.



## HIGHLIGHTS OF PAUL'S LIFE

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Missionary Journey, Acts 18:23-21:16.
  - ✓ Paul had sent Titus to Corinth, 2 Cor. 7:5-7.
  - ✓ When Paul left Ephesus, he went to Troas, then to Macedonia, looking for Titus, 2 Cor. 2:13-13.
  - ✓ Paul sent Titus to Corinth again, 2 Cor. 8:6, 16-17, 23.
  - ✓ Titus' ministry had been good, 2 Cor. 12:17-18.



## HIGHLIGHTS OF PAUL'S LIFE

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Missionary Journey, Acts 18:23-21:16.
  - ✓ Paul had sent Titus to Corinth, 2 Cor. 7:5-7.
  - ✓ When Paul left Ephesus, he went to Troas, then to Macedonia, looking for Titus, 2 Cor. 2:13-13.
  - ✓ Paul sent Titus to Corinth again, 2 Cor. 8:6, 16-17, 23.
  - ✓ Titus' ministry had been good, 2 Cor. 12:17-18.
- Paul concludes the 3<sup>rd</sup> Missionary Journey at Jerusalem, Acts 21:15-17.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF PAUL'S LIFE

- 2-year imprisonment in Caesarea, Acts 21:18 - 26:32.
- Journey to Rome, Acts 27:1–16.
- 2-year imprisonment in Rome, Acts 28:17-31.





## HIGHLIGHTS OF PAUL'S LIFE

- Released from prison to travel again!
  - ✓ Visit to Ephesus, 1 Timothy 1:3. (Left Timothy there.)
  - ✓ Visit to Macedonia, 1 Tim. 1:3.
  - ✓ Visit to Crete with Titus, Titus 1:5.
  - ✓ Visit to Nicopolis, Titus 3:12.
  - ✓ Visit to Troas and Miletus, 2 Tim. 4:13, 20
  - ✓ Final imprisonment in Rome, 2 Timothy
    - Sent Titus to Dalmatia, 2 Tim. 4:10



## TITUS' DISCIPLESHIP...

- Was with Paul & Barnabas in Antioch & traveled with them on the “Famine Visit.”
- Was with Paul in Ephesus on 3<sup>rd</sup> Miss. Journey.
  - ✓ Paul sent him to Corinth
  - ✓ He met Paul in Macedonia and returned to Corinth.

## TITUS' DISCIPLESHIP...

- After Paul's 1<sup>st</sup> Imprisonment...
  - ✓ He traveled with Paul to Crete and Paul left him there.
  - ✓ He joined Paul in Nicopolis.
  - ✓ He traveled with Paul to Rome.
  - ✓ Paul sent him to Dalmatia.

## Why Study Titus???

- It is God-Breathed Scripture, 2 Timothy 3:16-17.
- Titus was serving in a sinful, hostile culture.
- Titus had been discipled by the Apostle Paul!
- Titus has instructions for a local church!
- Titus has guidance for everyone!
- Titus has a highly developed Theology!

## Why Study Titus???

- Titus is intensely practical: the “Good Works Book”!
  - ✓ Unbelievers are worthless for any good works, 1:16
  - ✓ Salvation is not on the basis of good deeds, 3:4-5.
  - ✓ Leaders are to lead in good works, 1:8; 2:7.

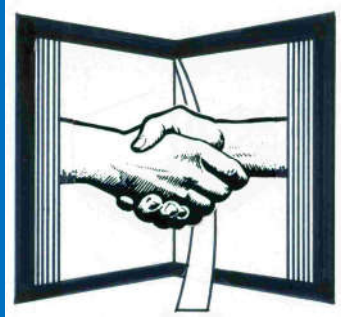
## Why Study Titus???

- Titus is intensely practical: the “Good Works Book”!
  - ✓ Believers are to be actively performing good works...
    - Zealous for Good deeds, 2:14
    - Ready for every good deed, 3:1
    - Careful to engage in good deeds, 3:8.
    - Must learn to engage in good deeds, 3:14.
