After of the Captivity, the returnees

- Rebuilt the altar in about **536 B.C.**,
Ezra 3:1-3
- Laid the foundation for the temple,
Ezra 3:7-10, 11-13
- Work on the temple stopped! Ezra 4!
- Work remained stopped...until
Haggai and Zechariah, about 520 BC

After of the Captivity

Haggai and Zechariah
were contemporaries!

Their prophetic ministries
to Judah overlapped

Portrait of the
Coming Messiah

Zechariah 9:9-14

“Rejoice greatly,
O daughter of Zion!
Shout *in triumph*,
O daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, your king is coming to you;
He is just and
endowed with salvation,
Humble, and mounted on a donkey,
Even on a colt,
the foal of a donkey.

I will cut off the chariot
from Ephraim

And the horse from Jerusalem;
And the bow of war will be cut off.

And He will speak peace
to the nations;

And His dominion will be
from sea to sea,

And from the River
to the ends of the earth.

As for you also,
because of the blood
of *My* covenant with you,
I have set your prisoners free
from the waterless pit.

Return to the stronghold,
O prisoners who have the hope;
This very day I am declaring
that I will restore double to you.

For I will bend Judah
as My bow,
I will fill the bow with Ephraim.
And I will stir up your sons,
O Zion,
against your sons,
O Greece;
And I will make you like
a warrior's sword.

Then Yahweh will appear
over them,
And His arrow will go forth
like lightning;
And the Lord Yahweh
will blow the trumpet,
And will march in the storm winds
of the south.
