But *it is* not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all Israel who are *descended* from Israel; nor are they all children because they are Abraham's descendants, but: "THROUGH ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS WILL BE NAMED."

That is, it is not the children of the flesh
who are children of God,
but the children of the promise
are regarded as descendants.
For this is the word of promise:
"AT THIS TIME I WILL COME,
AND SARAH SHALL HAVE A SON."

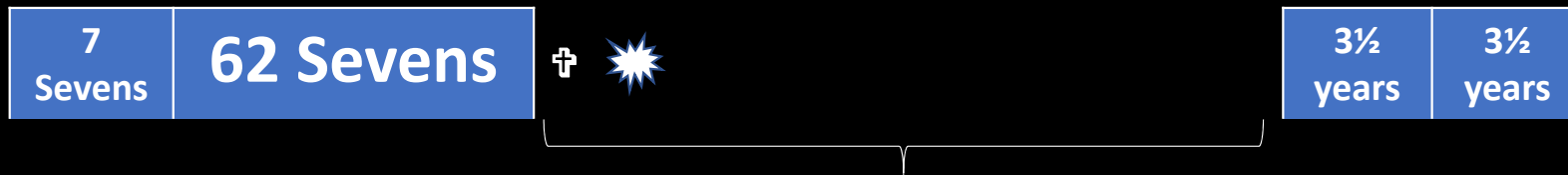
And not only this,
but there was Rebekah also,
when she had conceived *twins* by one man,
our father Isaac;
for though *the twins* were not yet born
and had not done anything good or bad,
so that God's purpose according to *His*
choice would stand, not because of works
but because of Him who calls,

The Bible is clear that God has chosen!

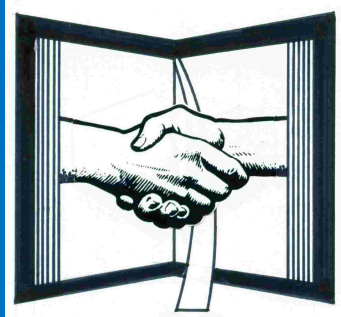
But Chosen WHOM...and for WHAT?

ELECTION

- The Father chose the Son to be the Savior, Luke 9:35.
- God chose some for blessing: Abraham; Isaac; Jacob; Judah
- God chose some for service: David, Paul, Peter.
- God chose some for salvation???

CONCLUSION...

- God's Word has not failed. God made the promise that He would bless Israel. And as God, HE gets to decide who constitutes "Israel."
- By His definition, His promise will be fulfilled...perfectly!
- And we can trust that He will fulfill all of His promises to us, as well!
