God's Will:

I will destroy them with the earth v. 13

- God has the ability to do this
- God is righteous
- God is gracious

I will make my covenant with you v. 18

- Is there anything God cannot do?
- What is a covenant?
 - Royal Grant treaty
 - Suzerain-Vassal treaty
- Why does God make this covenant?
 - cf. v. 9

1. Make yourself an ark v. 14a

7. You shall bring two of every sort of living thing vv. 19-20
8. You shall gather food for you and for them v. 21
