

Context and Overview of Ruth

Chapter 1:

It is the time of the Judges. There was a famine in Israel.

Naomi and Elimelech, from Bethlehem traveled to Moab with

their two sons, Mahlon and Chilion, who then married Moabite

women, Orpah and Ruth. Elimelech, Mahlon and Chilion all die,

leaving Naomi, Ruth and Orpah widows. Naomi returns to Israel.

Ruth, expressing her love, goes with her.

Context and Overview of Ruth

Chapter 2:

Back in Bethlehem, Ruth offers to provide for Naomi and herself by gleaning the barley harvest in fields of Boaz - who was a wealthy landowner and close relative of Naomi. Boaz notices Ruth and knows she is the daughter-in law of Naomi. Boaz shows kindness and care for Ruth by providing protection and extra barley grain for Ruth to glean.
